

Once all payments have been successfully cleared, the Handover Team will be granted a Release Letter.

Upon receipt of instructions through the Release Letter, the Handover Team (Jonathan, Nadiah, and Nadhirah) will promptly coordinate and confirm appointments with purchasers. These appointments will facilitate physical inspections of the office units and the subsequent handover of keys. Do take note that appointments will be scheduled on a first-come-first-served basis, upon completion of the final settlement process.

WELCOME TO THE MET!

CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER, RICHARD KHOO SHARES WITH US THE AREA'S CULINARY OFFERINGS, PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS, AND INFORMATION ON RENOVATION PROCESSES.

WHERE ARE THE NEAREST F&B ESTABLISHMENTS?

At The MET Corporate Towers, you can explore a diverse selection of culinary options at the Food Garden located at Level 9, which is a food hall that offers a range of local varieties. You can also find a selection of Malaysian fusion, Nyonya cuisine, Western dishes, and cafes to choose from, offering a diverse selection to satisfy every palate.

Moreover, The MET is surrounded by an abundance of dining destinations. To the South, you'll find food havens such as Publika, Solaris Mont Kiara, Plaza Damas, Plaza Mont Kiara, Arcoris and Desa Sri Hartamas. To the North-West, there is Segambut, Kepong and Jinjang, while to the East, you can explore Jalan Ipoh and Sentul. All these options are conveniently located within a 5km drive from The MET.

WHAT ARE THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AVAILABLE?

There are 2 existing public bus transport services: GoKL and MRT Feeder Bus.

GoKL is currently a free bus service provided by DBKL. The 'Magenta' line which links the Jinjang MRT Station to Publika passes by The MET daily from 7 am to 8 pm including public holidays with frequency varying from 15 minutes per bus to 30 minutes based on peak and non-peak hours respectively. Less than a 5-minute walk away, the nearest bus stop is 'Duta Kensington' and 'Kuarters Kerajaan Jalan

Duta'. We recommend using the mobile app 'GoKL' available on Android and iOS for the latest updates and changes.

The MRT Feeder Bus T852 connects the 'Pusat Bandar Damansara' MRT Station (Entrance B) to Solaris Mont Kiara (nearest stop to The MET). The fare starts from RM1 with a frequency of 15 to 30 minutes depending on traffic conditions. Senior citizens, students and disabled persons enjoy a 50% discount on rides while children under 7 years old ride for free. We hope to engage with Prasarana to extend the T852 route to include The MET.

WHEN CAN I START FIT-OUT / RENOVATION?

You may submit your ID plan to the appointed building management company, Henry Butcher Mont Kiara Sdn Bhd (HBMK) for review. HBMK will carefully review the ID plan in accordance with The MET House Rules and Deed of Mutual Covenant (DMC) to ensure full compliance.

Upon Vacant Possession (VP), your contractor may then submit to DBKL for authorities' approval. DBKL will evaluate the safety aspects of fire (Bomba) and building structure (engineering) before granting final approval.



The path is, however, not without costs but it is essential for us to decide whether this is a 'need' or a 'want.' Not recognising and accepting it as a 'need' can lead to disastrous consequences for future generations.

ZERO IS HERO

MALAYSIA'S ROADMAP TO NET ZERO

REDUCING EMISSION



The right to "a clean, healthy and sustainable environment" is now a human right as declared by the United Nations (UN). In welcoming the move, UN Secretary General Antonio Guterres said the resolution reflects the fact that member nations can now band together to fight against the triple planetary crisis of climate change, biodiversity loss and pollution. This, however, is just the beginning and that it is the duty of member nations to make this new "right" a reality.

A look at the news headlines and it is apparent that the kinds of environmental issues faced today are unlike those faced in previous decades. Future generations will have to cope with issues like climate change and the over-use of natural resources. The threat of pollution and deforestation continue to hover over communities. Rising sea levels, erratic temperatures and devastating storms are just some of the consequences of recent threats to the environment.

Now, with the resolution, it means that communities are empowered to demand better conditions for themselves.

THE MALAYSIAN SITUATION

According to the Sustainable Development Report 2021, Malaysia ranked 65 out of 165 countries with an SDG Index at 70.9. In 2021, Malaysia was reported to have achieved one of the 17 goals set by the UN, that of poverty eradication. The nation is also reportedly on track in terms of the goals of affordable and clean energy while scoring moderate on sustainable cities and communities. In terms of climate action, however, Malaysia received a stagnating score.

The Malaysian government, however, remains committed to reducing 30% emissions by 2030 and 50% by 2040, compared to those seen in 2005. While the 12th Malaysia Plan has

also specified a net zero target for GHG emissions by 2050.

Datuk Seri Michael Yam calls for a holistic approach involving regulators, NGOs, institutions and stakeholders to enable a more sustainable industry. These include specifying minimum standards for heat gain, water consumption, recycling performance and setting a minimum percentage of local products to be used. The role of clients and institutions is to raise the bar in terms of adopting best practices in sustainability by specifying that buildings need to be green-rated. This, in turn, will ensure that consultants incorporate latest technological innovations in their design.
